An individual scholarship of \$1,500 will be awarded. The award is applicable to tuition and fees only and will be paid by AAUW to the college, university, vocational, or technical school. Documented proof of continuation or acceptance into a 2014 program of study is required. The award must be used by the end of the 2014 calendar year. Previous recipients are eligible for consideration, but must reapply.

Application Instructions:

The application process requires the applicant to review the eligibility requirements, print a copy of the application, include the required enclosures, and mail a completed and signed application by the postmarked deadline.

- ❖ Women age 25 or older
- ❖ Resident of Beaufort County, South of the Broad River
- ❖ Earned a secondary school diploma or a GED
- ❖ Current or planned enrollment in a full or part-time program at an accredited 2 or 4 year institution of higher education
